Sign up to have a US Coast Guard Auxiliary Courtesy Safety Inspection completed right at your own dock. This is a great way to make sure your boat has all that is required to stay safe on the water and once you have passed, you will be awarded the safety sticker to display on your boat!

BSIBC member Bill Bareither, US Coast Guard Auxiliary vessel examiner, will conduct the inspection. There is no charge and no consequences if you don't pass. Our goal is simply to help make boating as safe as possible for you, your family and your friends, through education.
