Let the dispatcher know that you are reporting a late return or check-in by the persons on board. The dispatcher will guide you from there. The dispatcher will provide you with the necessary contact or agency connection to get a Search and Rescue (SAR) mission started. Be patient, stay off the phone so emergency personnel can contact you.
