

Fishing Mentor Checklist

Mentor's Rules – The boat captain has the final say for all rules on board regarding his boat, unless Mentor deems an unsafe condition. The mentor has the final say for all rules on board regarding fishing. The following checklist is to be used as a guide to help everyone understand what is to be expected. Generally, each individual is to furnish their own food and drink and have required fishing license/stamps for targeted species. Vessels should have current license and registration and current safety inspection and required safety and flotation devices for all vessel occupants (compliance with all FWC rules and regulations). It is recommended that a “float Plan” be made and entrusted to a relative or good friend.
