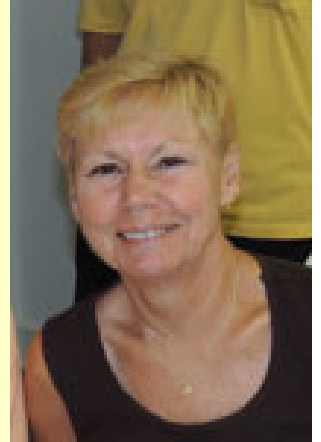
South Seas trip will be then. We have some more ideas for the fall and we will talk about them in the next UTC.
